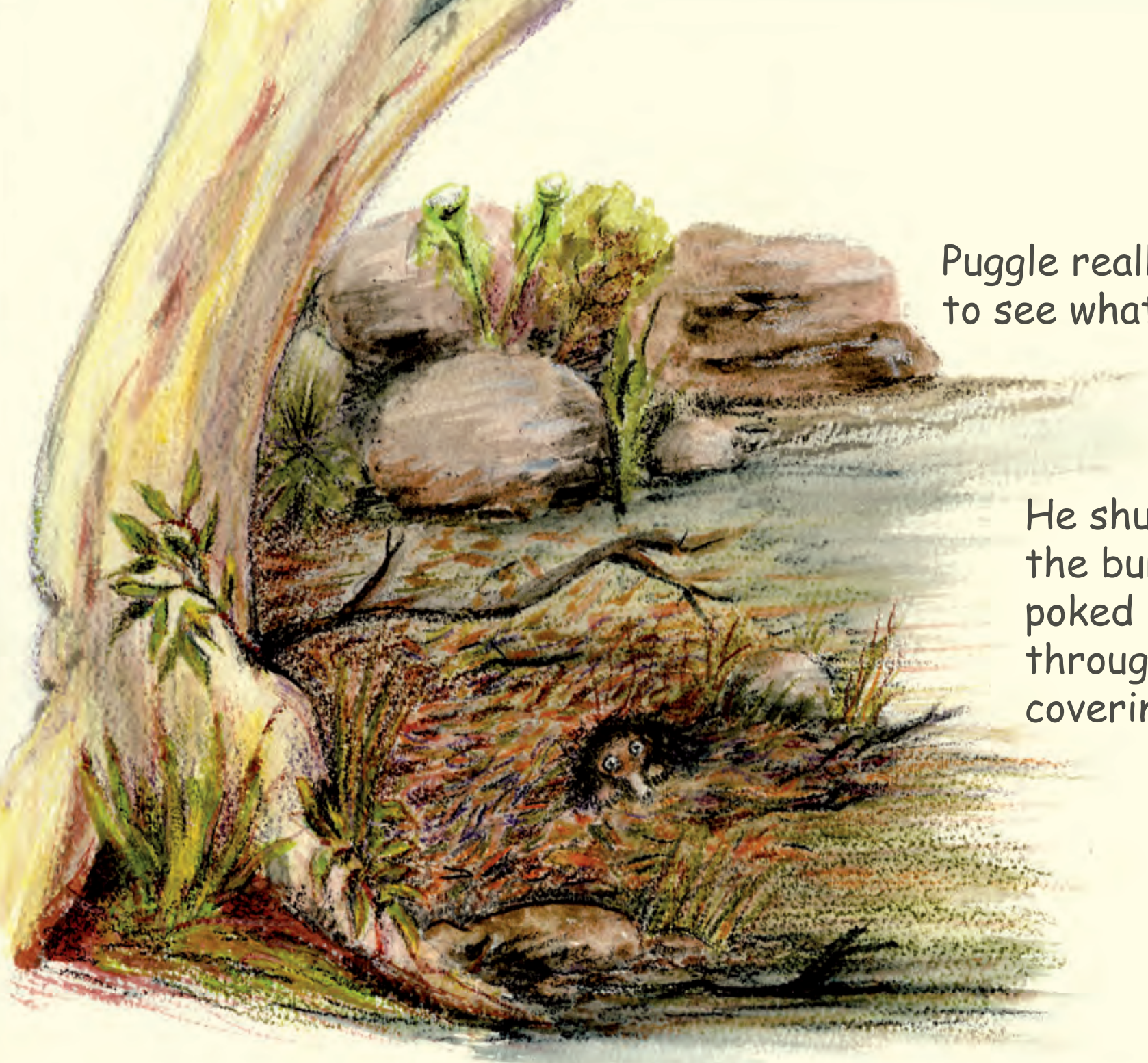
Puggle wanted to go with his mother.
